



Witchlets in the Woods: A Reclaiming Family Camp

2009 Registration Information and Form

CAMP DATES: Saturday, August 8 through Wednesday, August 12, 2009

LOCATION: Witchlets in the Woods, an all-ages exploration into the power of ritual and magic in community will be held at Mendocino Woodlands State Park, Camp II, near the towns of Mendocino and Fort Bragg. Each family cluster (self determined) can have their own cabin space. Some tent camping is also available. Campers provide their own bedding or sleeping bags. Map, directions, and details on what you will need to bring will be sent later in an information packet.

Please note: Mendocino Woodlands State park is not designated wheelchair accessible. However, the park may have some accessible features, such as parking areas, restrooms, and routes of travel, that meet some of the current accessibility guidelines. Contact us for more information.

FOOD: The camp's kitchen and dining room will serve delicious community meals including offerings for vegans, vegetarians, and meat eaters. Witchlets in the Woods is drug and alcohol free during the length of camp except for prescription drugs, medicinal herbs, nicotine, and caffeine.

RAFFLE: We will hold a raffle to raise funds for Witchlets. Please bring donations for the raffle to camp!

CAMP FEE: \$180 per adult, \$160 per camper 5 to 18 years old, and children 4 years old and younger are free. The fee includes all activities, facilities, utilities and services, and organic meals. Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Donations are appreciated, to help us continue to make this event affordable to all families, and to provide scholarships for next year's camp. Please inquire about scholarship fund availability.

DEPOSIT: \$50 per person age five and older due with registration. The remainder of the fee should be paid by June 1, 2009. Camp is limited to 105 participants, and will be filled on a first come basis. Camp fills very fast so don't delay.

REFUND POLICY: The \$50 per person deposit is non-refundable. For the remaining balance, 50% refund if canceled by July 1; 25% refund if canceled by July 16. There is no refund for cancellations made after this.
